-Fencing materials – pressure treated wood as follows:

250 - 5" X 6' in-line fence posts

10 - 10" X 8' fence posts - corner post & gate post

375 - 1" X 6" X 16' rough sawn pine boards

4 - 12' gates with hardware

50lbs - 12d galv common nails

20lbs - 2 1/2 " exterior galv screws

50lbs - 1 1/2 " fence staples

20-60lb bags concrete mix

10 rolls No-Climb horse fencing 200' per roll

-Professional volunteer help to oversee fencing and construction projects

-Horse feed; Hay; Lead ropes; Sturdy buckets; Halters (break-away only)
